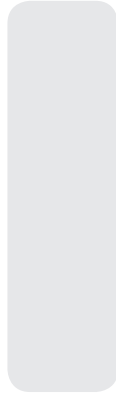


Theories about money

Three clever men had a think about money. Models of their heads are lined up next to each other in the museum. One of them is wearing glasses and has a beard.

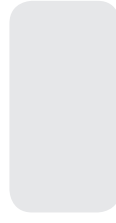
What is his last name?

At the top of a high wall in the museum there are lots of different heads. These are the members of the Governing Council of the European Central Bank, who look after our money.

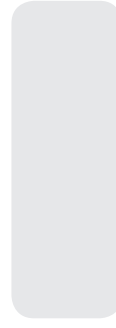
How many members are there? Count the heads!

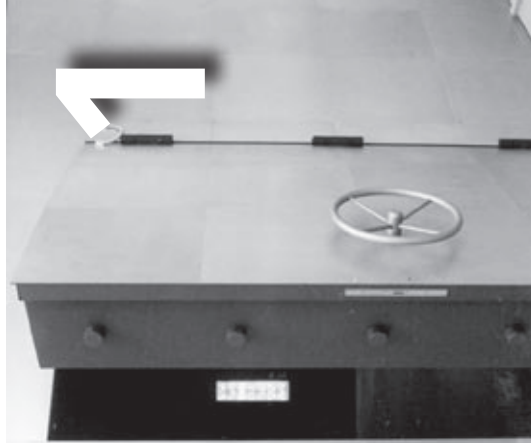

euro coins.

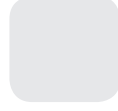
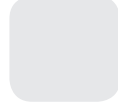
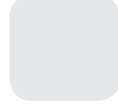
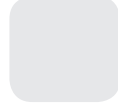
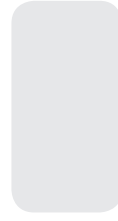
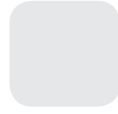
How many stars are there on the back of each coin?

made in.

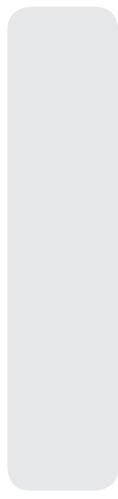
What are the five letters?

Go to the three silver posts which have lots of doors with letters on them.

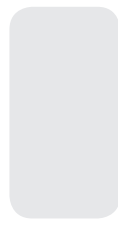
What is behind the door with the letter Q on it?

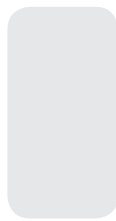

Can you find the glass pillar with the shredded money in it? That is how the Bundesbank destroys old and dirty banknotes. Some shreds are pressed into packets.

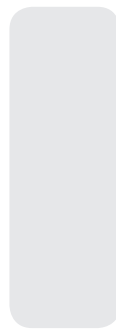
How many packets are there at the bottom of the glass pillar?
